- Campers in full-day camps should bring a sack lunch. Children in the half-day (9:00-12:00) camp do not need a lunch.
- To register for Outdoor Adventures, cut off and fill out the attached registration form (both sides). Full payment must be enclosed. Make checks payable to **St. Joseph County Parks**.

- Campers must register for the camp designated for their age group.

Finish up the week with an overnight camp out. This week of camp includes several off-site field trips to unique natural destinations.

Be prepared for an off-site adventure as we take a 4-mile canoe trip down the St. Joseph River. Learn basic paddling, steering and safety techniques; watch turtles, herons and other wildlife and stop on an island for a picnic lunch.
