



Chamberlain Lake Nature Preserve

This site is located on Crumstown Highway, 3.5 miles west of the intersection of Mayflower Road and Sample Street. The Parks entered into cooperative agreement with the Division of Nature Preserves in 1997 to coordinate management of this 82-acre nature preserve on the west side of Chamberlain Lake. Originally donated by the Indiana Chapter of The Nature Conservancy, ownership has been retained by the Division of Nature Preserves, with County Park staff helping to develop and maintain this tract. Limited development will occur at this site where a 1.5 mile trail system has been established.
