It is not per defendant to be served. It is a flat fee of \$28.00 pre-judgment. **Post-judgment fee sheriff's fee also \$28.00.**

**IC 33-37-5-28 (Effective July 1, 2017) eliminated the \$10.00 per additional defendant fee when a county implements electronic filing of cases. However, case filed by paper is still charged this fee until July 18, 2017 when mandatory e-filing begins in St. Joseph County Courts.
