

Spider Headbands



Spiders are different from insects, in part because they have 8 legs. Most also have 4 or eight eyes!

You need (for each child)

One 1 ½-inch wide by 24-inch long strip of construction paper for the headband

Eight 1-inch by 11-inch paper legs (see attached for cutting template)

Two eyes (see attached for pattern)

Glue sticks, tape or staplers

Secure headband, attach eyes. Attach the legs to the inside of the headband. Bend the legs in various places to give them shape.

Tip – if you attach the legs to the band with the long end up, and bend them down over the headband, the spider will be wider (see below). If you attach them long end down, the spider will be skinnier as in photo above.



If you use a stapler to secure pieces, attach with the rough side of the staple towards the outside.
